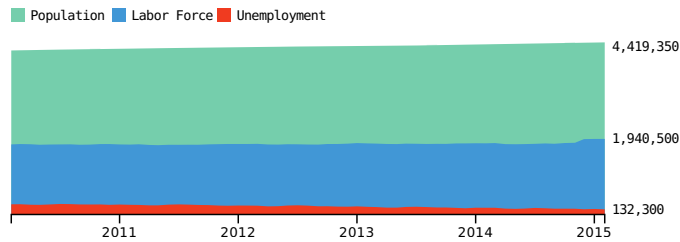

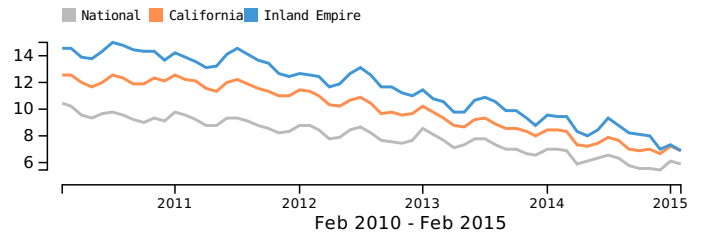

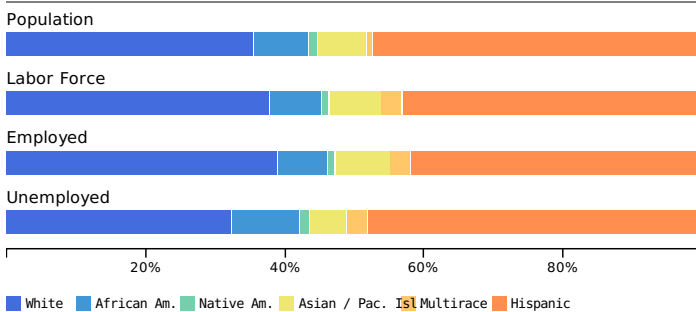


Unemployment Over Time

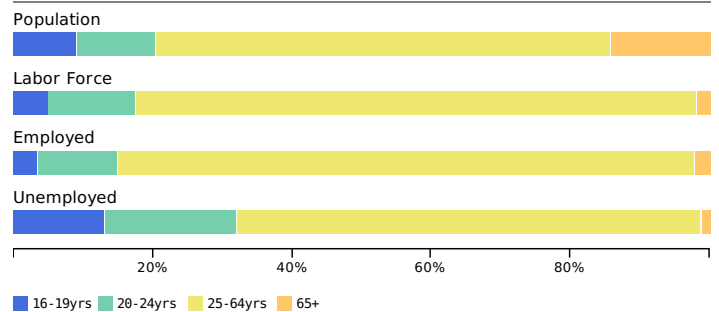

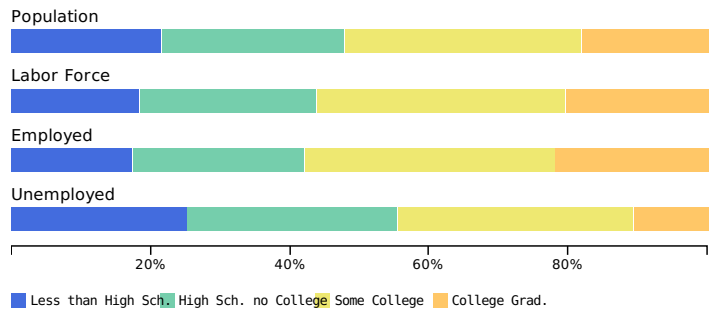
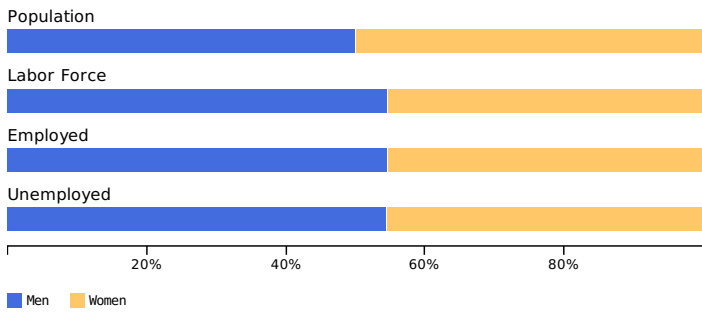

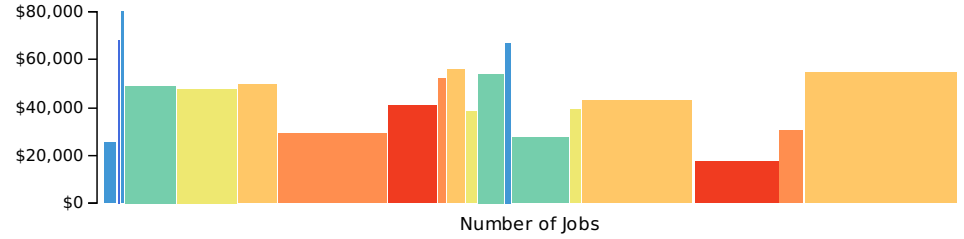
