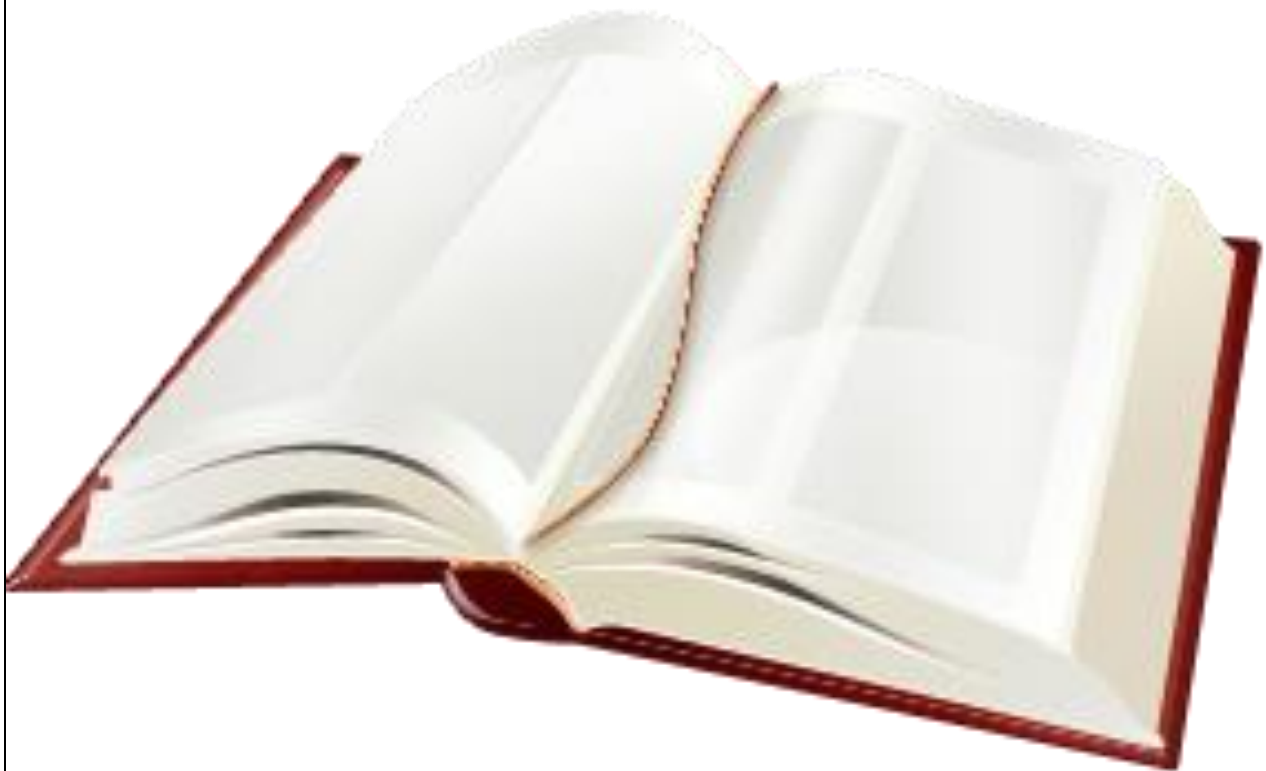

The training and test are available online 24 hours a day, 7 days a week and cost \$22. Only credit, debit and prepaid debit cards are accepted.
